COMLINC 2.0 is a state funded interoperability partnership with the Commonwealth's localities.

The partnership includes the COMLINC Advisory Group (CAG) composed of local, regional, and state representatives. The CAG advises the State Interoperability Executive Committee (SIEC) composed of state-wide interoperability leaders. The SIEC advises localities, regions, the Governor & General Assembly.

Partnering with stakeholders throughout the state, the CAG will lead development of Standard Operating Procedures, prioritize the technology refresh & training site selection, and advise sustainment requirements.
